NOTICE TO INTERESTED AND AFFECTED PARTIES REGARDING WATER AUTHORISATION APPLICATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITIONAL PIPELINE, PUMP STATION AND ASSOCIATED BOREHOLES AT THE BOSJESSPRUIT COLLIERY, MPUMALANGA

AVAILABILITY OF THE DRAFT INTEGRATED WATER AND WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT

Dear Interested and Affected Party,

1. Introduction

Digby Wells Environmental and Associates (hereinafter Digby Wells) was appointed by Sasol Mining (Pty) Ltd Bosjesspruit Colliery (Bosjesspruit) to prepare a Water Use Licence Application (WULA) for the proposed BS6 Project (Phase 2) at the Bosjesspruit Colliery within the Govern Mbeki Local Municipality, Mpumalanga Province.

The Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) issued a General Authorisation (GA) in terms of General Authorisation no 4167 dated 8 December 2023 for the first phase of the project and has subsequently requested Bosjesspruit to apply for a WULA for the second phase.

The proposed Phase 2 of the BS6 Project forms part of Bosjesspruit's operational infrastructure and includes:

- Construction of an additional pipeline and pump station within an existing servitude; and
- Drilling of five groundwater boreholes with associated infrastructure.

This WULA is submitted for a second pipeline that will run parallel to the abovementioned authorised pipeline from BS6 to BS4 within the regulated buffer area of 500 m from a delineated wetland and the drilling of five boreholes. All pipeline infrastructure will be established on an already existing servitude.

1.1. Environmental Regulatory Process:

A WUL application is undertaken to fulfil the legislation requirements of the proposed project by means of:

- Water Use Authorisation in terms of Section 40 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998).



1.2. Project Locality

The project is located within the Govan Mbeki Local Municipality and the Gert Sibande District Municipality, approximately 10 km north-east of Charl Cilliers and 8 km south of Secunda.

1.3. Public Participation Process

Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs), including neighbouring landowners, community members, government authorities, organisations and other stakeholders, are invited to register and submit comments during the review period.
