Dear Interested and Affected Party,

Digby Wells Environmental and Associates (hereinafter Digby Wells) was appointed by Sasol Mining (Pty) Ltd Bosjesspruit Colliery (Bosjesspruit) to prepare a Water Use Licence Application (WULA) for the proposed BS6 Project (Phase 2) at the Bosjesspruit Colliery within the Govern Mbeki Local Municipality, Mpumalanga Province.

The Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) issued a General Authorisation (GA) in terms of General Authorisation no 4167 dated 8 December 2023 for the first phase of the project and has subsequently requested Bosjesspruit to apply for a WULA for the second phase.

The proposed Phase 2 of the BS6 Project forms part of Bosjesspruit's operational infrastructure and includes:

- Construction of an additional pipeline and pump station within an existing servitude; and
- Drilling of five groundwater boreholes with associated infrastructure.

This WULA is submitted for a second pipeline that will run parallel to the abovementioned authorised pipeline from BS6 to BS4 within the regulated buffer area of 500 m from a delineated wetland and the drilling of five boreholes. All pipeline infrastructure will be established on an already existing servitude.

Digby Wells is required to comply with the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act No. 4 of 2013) (POPIA) which took effect on 01 July 2021. The purpose of POPIA to regulate and formalise how South African companies collect, store, protect, access, and distribute consumer information and to protect the ongoing integrity and sensitivity of that private information.
